**Title:** National Professional Qualification Leading Behaviour and Culture

**Duration: 12 Months** 

Modules: 3 (each 12 weeks study time)

Face to Face and Webinar Hours: 24 hours for

whole course

Online Learning Hours: 40 hours for whole

course (1-2 hours per week)

Coaching Hours: 6 hours for whole course

**Assessment:** Summative case study at the end

of the course

#### How will I be assessed?

#### There are two success criteria for the course:

- Participation in at least 90% of the course
- Successfully pass the summative case study assessment

The summative assessment requires you to answer three questions in response to a case study. The assessment windows are set at the start of your course and there is an 8-day period to complete the assessment.

#### **Modules**

The course is comprised of three modules over 12 months. Each module lasts 12 weeks. The modules cover all of the 'learn that and learn how to' statements from the NPQ Leading Behaviour and Culture Framework Document.
